


VOENA is a world-renowned children's choir and 501(c)3

What We Do

VOENA provides **students ages 6 to 18** with the opportunity to discover their voices and build self-confidence through song and movement. Vocal arrangements incorporate multiple percussion instruments, dance, and theatrical elements.

The a cappella group represents more than **35 cultures** and sings new and traditional songs in over **30 languages** and dialects.



The concert level choir has **performed in communities around the world** including South Africa, Japan, China, London, Ireland, Italy, Bali and others.

Most are Title I Schools, serving the largest number of low-income families in Benicia and Napa. This popular and fast-growing program reaches thousands of K-5 students.

What we Accomplish with your Support

Over the past twenty years VOENA has helped hundreds of children and youth find their voices. The group has traveled the globe as goodwill ambassadors, performing five times at the White House for President and First Lady Clinton and Bush, at the opening day 2012 London Summer Olympics, at the International Soweto Festival in South Africa and at the World Expo in Aichi, Japan in 2005, among others. A number of alumni have gone on to receive full scholarships to college or have built their careers in music.

Our Need

Each year VOENA must raise up to half of its budget through contributions to make its programs accessible to all children who wish to participate. Through increasing the number of contributions received annually, VOENA will be able to keep tuition costs low and increase the number of scholarships offered. VOENA also works hard to keep its overhead costs low by leveraging support from donors, volunteers and community partners. At least 80% of all income goes directly towards VOENA's programs.
